Objective	The purpose of the seminar is to introduce to the most important conceptual approaches of research as well as to explore and formulate the framework for the analysis of the topic.
Brief report	<p>Research methodology simply refers to the practical “how” of any given piece of research. More specifically, it’s about how a researcher systematically designs a study to ensure valid and reliable results that address the research aims and objectives. For example, how did the researcher go about deciding:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What data to collect (and what data to ignore)</li> <li>• Who to collect it from (in research, this is called “sampling design”)</li> <li>• How to collect it (this is called “data collection methods”)</li> <li>• How to analyze it (this is called “data analysis methods”)</li> </ul> <p>Importantly, a good methodology chapter in a dissertation or thesis explains not just what methodological choices were made, but also explains why they were made. Research methodology should justify the design choices, by showing that the chosen methods and techniques are the best fit for the research aims and objectives, and will provide valid and reliable results. A good research methodology provides scientifically sound findings, whereas a poor methodology doesn’t.</p> <p>There are different types of methodologies such as Qualitative, quantitative and mixed-methods, distinguished by whether they focus on words or numbers.</p>


