

COPYRIGHT LICENCE AGREEMENT

This agreement is dated 26 November 2018

PARTIES:

- THE WOOLMARK COMPANY PTY LTD (ACN 067 866 657) (acting for and on behalf of its affiliates and related entities) of Level 6, 68 Harrington Street, The Rocks, Sydney NSW Australia 2000 (Licensor); and
- 2. THE TECHNOLOGICAL INSTITUTE OF TEXTILE & SCIENCES (Company Number S/47450) of Birla Colony, tosham Road, Bhiwani Haryana 127021(Licensee).

BACKGROUND:

- A. The Licensor has created the contents of the Wool Science, Technology and Design Education Program including, but not limited to, all units, modules, aids, documents, notes, tutorial/ practical sheets, slides, images, videos, materials, certificates, assignments, guides, manuals and information contained therein (Materials) and is the owner of all Intellectual Property rights (IPR) subsisting in the Materials.
- B. The Licensee wishes to receive and the Licensor is willing to grant to the Licensee a licence to use the Materials on the terms and conditions set out in this agreement.

IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Grant of Licence. In consideration for the mutual promises made by both parties, the Licensor hereby grants to the Licensee a non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable, royalty-free licence to use, reproduce and copy the Materials for the purpose of delivering the Wool Science, Technology and Design Education Program within Licensee's institution (Purpose) for a period of 3 years from the date the Licensor provides the Materials to the Licensee (Licence Term).

2. Use, Quality, Control, Marking.

- Unless prior written consent is provided by the Licensor, the Licensee must only use the Materials for the permitted Purpose.
- b Unless prior written consent is provided by the Licensor, the Licensee must only reproduce the Materials in the form provided by the Licensor without making any alterations or amendments and shall not allow the Materials to be published.
- c. The Licensee may arrange for the Materials to be translated as necessary and must note that the translation was done by the Licensee (in the form set out in Schedule 1). The Licensor reserves the right to check any translated versions of the Materials and request any reasonable amendments prior to publication or distribution by the Licensee.
- d. The Licensee must ensure any copies or reproduction of the Materials contain the disclaimer set out in Schedule 1 on the first page of the Materials.
- Ownership of IPR in Materials. The parties agree and acknowledge that the Licensor is the owner of all IPR subsiding in the Materials, which may be varied from time to time by the Licensor.
- 4. Protection of Copyright. The Licensee will immediately notify the Licensor in writing if it becomes aware of any actual, suspected or threatened infringement of the Materials. The Licensor will, at its sole discretion, decide whether to take any action.
- Feedback and Reporting. The Licensee must provide written reports to the Licensor on dates and covering subject advised by the Licensor.

- 6. Indemnity. The Licensee indemnifies the Licensor and its associated entities against all liabilities, expenses, losses, claims, damages and costs (on a solicitor and own client basis and whether incurred by or awarded against those indemnified) arising out of or in connection with the Licensee's exercise of its rights granted under this agreement or the Licensee's breach or negligent performance of this agreement.
- 7. Assignment and Other Dealings. The Licensee shall not assign, sub-licence, transfer or otherwise deal in any manner with its rights under this agreement without the prior written consent of the Licensor.
- 8. Term and Termination. This agreement will commence upon signature by both parties and will continue for the duration of the Licence Term. This agreement expires automatically upon expiry of the Licence Term. The Licensor may terminate this agreement by notice to the Licensee with immediate effect.
- Governing Law. This agreement is governed by the laws of New South Wales. Australia. The parties irrevocably submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of New South Wales, Australia.
